



Rules of the Talent Contest

"Erasmus Talent Show"

13 December 2017

§ 1. Organizer of the Contest

1.1. The International Cooperation Centre of Lodz University of Technology is the organizer of the "Erasmus Talent Show" (hereinafter referred to as "the Contest").

§ 2. Objectives of the Contest

2.1. Objectives of the Contest:

- promotion of the Erasmus+ Programme among students during the 8th Mobility Week organized by Lodz University of Technology,
- encouraging students of Lodz University of Technology to study and do internships within the Erasmus+ Programme,
- engaging Erasmus+ Programme participants and foreign students arriving at Lodz University of Technology as well as other students and employees of Lodz University of Technology in multicultural activities organized at Lodz University of Technology.

§ 3. Participants

3.1. All students and employees of Lodz University of Technology are entitled to participate in the Contest.

3.2. The persons who declared their participation in the Contest on the terms and conditions set forth in these Rules are hereinafter referred to as "Participants".

3.3. The Participants who fail to comply with any of the requirements set out in these Rules or who furnish false information shall be automatically disqualified.



§ 4. Subject of the Contest

- 4.1. The subject of the Contest is to present artistic talents in the form of a short performance on the day, and at the venue and time of the Contest.
- 4.2. The presentation time of each Participant shall not exceed 5 minutes.
- 4.3. The artistic talent to be presented may be any type of an activity which is socially acceptable and does not violate the general social principles and it involves, for example, singing, dance, painting, music, acting, poetry etc. Making references to the multi-culturalism shall be an added advantage.
- 4.4. During the performance, inappropriate gestures, movements, dances and the use of inappropriate lyrics or using words commonly regarded as abusive shall not be permitted. The performance shall not invoke negative feelings, shall not be incompatible with good morals, shall not refer to fascism, racism and its content shall not harm the good and dignity of third parties. The performance shall not endanger the lives and health of the Participants and their audience.
- 4.5. During the Participant's performance, the Health and Safety regulations as well as fire prevention regulations must not be violated.
- 4.6 The Organizer reserves the right to exclude a Participant at the registration stage if the Organizer deems the performance non-compliant with the requirements of point 4.4.
- 4.7 The Organizer also reserves the right to discontinue the performance and to disqualify the Participant if the content of the performance does not meet the requirements of point 4.4.

§ 5. Rules of declaring participation in the Contest

- 5.1. Participants interested in taking part in the "Erasmus Talent Show" shall submit a completed application form, which is available on the website erasmus.p.lodz.pl/mobility-week, by 03.00 p.m. on 5 December 2017 as well as submit in person these Rules in the paper form and signed by the Participant to Ms Joanna Auguścik (the building of the International Cooperation Centre of Lodz University of Technology, 90-924, ul. Żwirki 36, office no. 120, the Student Mobility Section).
- 5.2. Each Participant shall receive an email confirming their participation. Admission to the Contest shall be determined on the first come first served basis. Due to the time limitations, the number of participants may not exceed 20. Registration on the reserve list shall be allowed – in the event of resignation of any participant. Application forms submitted after the above mentioned time limit shall be considered only if the number of participants is less than 20.

§ 6. Organization of the Contest

- 6.1. The Contest will take place on 13 December 2017 at 06:00 p.m. in the Auditorium of Lodz University of Technology, al. Politechniki 3a, 90-924 Łódź. Prior to the main competition, an obligatory rehearsal shall take place at 04:00 p.m.
- 6.2. The Contest Participants shall adapt their performance to the technical capabilities of the Auditorium.
- 6.3. The Organizer shall provide sound and lighting equipment, microphones, a CD player, a multimedia projector; (please specify the required equipment in the application form), all other props required by the participants shall be provided by the Participants themselves.



6.4. Official results shall be announced on 13 December 2017 by the jury, the composition of which is included in the Appendix to these Rules, forthwith after the Contest.

6.5. Participation in the Contest is free of charge.

6.6. The Organizer shall not refund the costs of the travel or the costs related to the purchase of the props.

§ 7. Evaluation of participants and awards

7.1. Awards and gifts in the Contest are co-financed by the International Cooperation Centre and from the Erasmus+ Programme funds.

7.2. Three Participants who are awarded the highest number of points by the jury shall be deemed winners of the Contest, assuming that the person with the highest number of points wins the first prize.

7.3. The winners shall be announced on 13 December 2017, immediately after the Contest and the deliberation of the jury, and their names shall be posted on the website erasmus.p.lodz.pl and on the events page on Facebook.

7.4. The winners shall be awarded the following prizes:

- The first place in the Contest: **a voucher of PLN 800 for the purchase of air tickets or other Sports-Tourist services**
- The second place in the Contest: **a cinema voucher for two persons and a wireless speaker**
- The third place in the Contest: **a cinema voucher for two persons and a “power bank” phone charger**

All remaining participants shall receive consolation prizes (cinema vouchers for 2 persons and promotional gifts).

7.5. The winners shall be presented with the prizes during the announcement of the Contest results. In the event of absence of any winner, the prizes may be collected from the Student Mobility Division at the International Cooperation Centre.

7.6. Participants consent to publishing their names, surnames, the faculty, the name of their home university and information on the received prizes on the Organizer's website and in other mass media for the purpose of publishing results of the Contest and promoting the event.



§ 8. General conditions

8.1. Each participant shall grant to Lodz University of Technology an irrevocable and gratuitous right of repeated use of photographs and recordings with their image from the event referred to in § 6 point 6.1, without the necessity of granting approval each time. The consent shall include, in particular, the use, recording, processing, and reproduction of photographs and recordings, captured or made with the use of any means, solely for promotional purposes.

8.2. The person who submits the application to participate in the Contest:

8.2.1 expresses consent to the processing of personal data for the purpose of organizing and carrying out the competition "Erasmus Talent Show" organized by the International Cooperation Centre of Lodz University of Technology in accordance with the Act of 29 August 1997 on the protection of personal data (consolidated text, the Journal of Laws 2016, item 922).

8.2.2 The applicant acknowledges that:

8.2.2.1 Lodz University of Technology with its registered office at ul. Żeromskiego 116, in Łódź, is the administrator of data collected during the Contest. The above data shall be collected solely for the purpose of organizing and carrying out the contest "Erasmus Talent Show".

8.2.2.2 The applicants shall have the right of access and amendment of the contents of their personal data. Provision of data is voluntary, but the refusal to provide them is tantamount to inability to participate in the contest.

8.2.2.3 The consent may be revoked at any time.

§ 9. Final provisions

9.1. These Rules shall be subject to publication on the website www.erasmus.p.lodz.pl, with the possibility of downloading and printing them.

9.2. In matters not governed by these Rules, the Director of the International Cooperation Centre of Lodz University of Technology shall take relevant decisions.

9.3. The Organizer shall reserve the right to amend these Rules.

9.4. These Rules shall come into force on the date of the announcement of the Contest.
